Position Title: Junior Head Coach

Group: Junior Cricket Teams

Employment Status: Voluntary

Reports to: Senior head Coach, Cricket Operations Manager, Executive Committee

Location: Whitehorse Reserve

Key Roles:

- Design and implement training program for all junior teams, including pre-season through to end of playing year.
- Ensure the training program aligns with the Cricket Australia and Cricket Victoria Guidelines for junior cricket skillsets
- Align the way junior teams play with the approach of the senior teams to ensure strong retention from junior to senior cricket
- Communicate to all team coaches regarding training expectations, how training is run and what is required of each team coach during the year
- Act as a point of contact for all junior players for their training and game performance
- Work with team coaches to fine tune training based on numbers, Skill outcomes and game performance.
- Where not coaching an individual team, attend as many junior games as possible to monitor the performance of the boys along with any skill focus required/coach feedback needed
- Establish a database of each player, rating their skill attributes and adjust this based on their progression each year.
- Address, along with the junior coordinator, any issues reported from a specific coach with parents and a child. Similarly, any issues reported of a coach's behaviour from parents of players.
- Act as chairman of selectors for selection of all junior teams with final say on the teams
- Communicate with junior sub-committee regarding support at training and games for coaches and any requirements for training.
