Role Description:

Junior Blasters is the entry point of many young kids into your cricket club. The Junior Blasters Program is easy to run. It not only helps get junior players into your club, but also provides a great opportunity to recruit new volunteers. The Program is specifically designed to be easy to run by club volunteers and parents with minimal coaching background. The Primary role of the Woolworths Blast Coordinator is to manage the program administration, liaise with the cricket club and organise the Blast Squads, Captains and Crew.

The Woolworths Blast Coordinator will be able to access the Junior Blasters Centre Management Section in MyCricket to setup their program and view participant registrations.

Key Roles:

- Work with Junior Coordinator to organise the Woolworth Blast Programs Junior Blast and Master Blaster
- Work with Cricket Club to utilise the MyCricket Blast Centre Management section to setup the program and view participant registrations.
- Ensure that each week there is a "Blast Captain" present to run the sessions, either a parent or member of the Cricket Club.
- Engage parents to be involved in the Blast Sessions from Day 1 to ensure they get the best experience with their child and are aware of how the program works.
- Inform parents and Blast Captains about the Woolworths Blast App which gives every session plan for you to run, and also gives activities for home
- Field all initial enquiries relating to Woolworths Blast in advance of the season and during the season from parents.
- Work with the club for budget around any Blast events, opportunities or social functions that may present through the year.
- Communicate any feedback from parents to the Junior Coordinator and Junior Sub-Committee to ensure that their needs are being met.
